

# 33° YAMAHA TR1. Rallye

Quinto di Treviso - Veneto - ITALIA

7-8-9 agosto 2020

The 33rd TR1 meeting will take place in Quinto di Treviso next to a beautiful lake formed by the Sile, the longest resurgence river in Europe.

The natural park of the river Sile, is an imposing park that has an area of 4152 hectares divided between the municipal territories of the provinces of Treviso, Venice and Padua.

It can be accessed from several entrances, including the one overlooking the area of springs in Vedelago.

Within this park it is possible to do not only many excursions, but

also many "bike rides" with friends thanks to the many cycling routes and visit some local buildings such as the old mill which now houses an ethnographic museum. A good way to immerse yourself in nature and at the same time breathe the atmosphere of Treviso.

The village of Quinto is only 5 km away. from Treviso, the city where I was born and I live. Although overshadowed by nearby Venice, Treviso boasts a similar network of canals and labyrinthine medieval streets, protected behind historic walls.

The newest part of the city hosts a bevy of museums and restaurants that serve the typical Treviso dessert: **tiramisu**.

**The Piazza dei Signori** in Treviso is the beating heart of the city and is the



point where your ideal tour should begin. From the architecture of the Roman period, Piazza dei Signori appears as an elegant and imposing meeting point thanks to the presence of the three most important buildings in the city, namely the Palazzo dei Trecento, the



Civic Tower and finally the Palazzo del Podestà, a building that dates back to the 1400s.

The Piazza dei signori is also a reference point for those who love shopping and high fashion thanks to the presence luxury boutiques and quaint shops.

Finally, from the Piazza dei Signori, one leads towards the Cathedral of Treviso,

thanks to the connection with the Calmaggione, a very pretty little alley surrounded by arcades that serves as the background to the square.

**Via Calmaggione** is the most characteristic and most important street of Treviso. Its peculiarity derives from the fact that it links the Cathedral of Treviso to the Piazza dei Signori, thus constituting the true link between religious and political life. Via Calmaggione is also above all the shopping street, thanks also to the numerous shops located all along the street and which over time have become the real point of reference for fashion lovers in the Treviso area.

The Fountain of the Tits, Walking along the Via Calmaggione, you are led to the Palazzo Zignoli where we find the famous **Fontana delle Tette**, so called because it looks visually like a bust from whose breasts water flows.

However, the statue that we can admire outside is an imitation.

**The Cathedral of Treviso**, built on an early Christian temple to which today we can only admire the Crypt, the cathedral of San Pietro Apostolo, known to most as the Cathedral of Treviso, is a splendid example of a Romanesque church.

The supporting element of the Cathedral is the six Ionic columns that stand out majestically from the large staircase on the façade.

Inside there are several valuable works, including the Annunciation by Titian. At the sides of the Cathedral we can finally admire the Baptistery of San Giovanni, which until about two centuries ago was the only baptismal font in all of Treviso.

**The Buranelli canal**, also called the Medio channel, the Buranelli canal is named after the famous Buranelli family, a powerful family of traders from the island of Burano, who populated this waterway during the sixteenth century.

The Buranelli canal is one of the most evocative, but also among the most romantic thanks to the many shops where you can walk the many restaurants where you can taste typical dishes of excellence.

I would also like to remind you that Treviso is the home of the PROSECCO wine from Valdobbiadene, of the PINARELLO family, producer of the famous racing bicycles, of the BENETTON family known for a chain of young clothing stores and for many years owner of Racing Team F1, the adoptive city of the famous motorcycle racer OMOBONO TENNI, the singer RED CANZIAN of the POOH band.



Its geographical position places it halfway between the mountains and the sea and therefore it is possible to climb MONTE GRAPPA (50 km.) To 1775 mt. where we can go to see one of the largest shrines in Italy of the Great War of 1915 - 18 and then go down to the

sea and find the beautiful **VENICE** (30 km) or **Jesolo Lido** (50 km) one of the most popular tourist destinations loved by tourists from northern Europe.
